(MSW) works to revitalize our downtown district in a variety of ways, such as providing support for new and existing businesses, beautification projects and hosting events and activities to attract visitors from outside of the area. We work to instill a sense of pride and



provide opportunities for enjoyment for all.

A Well-Rounded Downtown

Mainstreet Waynesboro strives to make downtown fun, safe, vibrant and diverse. One of the ways we accomplish that goal is to host events that bring people downtown to see our shops, restaurants and brewpub.

This year, we attracted thousands of people to our car and truck show, Waynesboro Wizarding Weekend and Market Day events along with Chocolate Excursion. In addition, we held our second Boro Sip & Stroll in May, our Downtown Food Stroll, Food Truck Fridays, and summer concerts at Main Street Park. Our goal is to continue



to have events that are safe, while generating foot traffic downtown to help support our Main Street businesses.

Our events help raise money for our organization, which is why we need your support more than ever in 2023.

Beautiful by Design

Mainstreet Waynesboro is tasked with keeping our downtown as safe, clean and green as possible.

Mainstreet provides funding for the beautiful flower baskets that hang in the downtown district each year, and we maintain the welcome signs at each entrance to town.

This year, Mainstreet continued to expand the One Brick at a Time

campaign and the veterans banner program. We added 12 beautiful planters throughout downtown and added brackets to borough light poles so we could honor more local veterans with the banners that hang in late fall.

Mainstreet awarded \$30,000 in state façade grant money in 2022 to keep our classic buildings looking their best.

MAIN STREET PARK



This beautiful downtown oasis has seen tens of thousands of visitors since it opened in October of 2017. The park has been the site of a bustling farmers market the past five summers, as well as a home to concerts, vigils,

art shows, Food Truck Fridays, birthday parties, class reunions, weddings, and our Boro Blast celebration.

Most of all, it is a place to relax with coffee from Brio or Christine's and a good book from Wee Scot Book Shoppe, or to enjoy the free Wi-Fi.

THE NATIONAL REGISTER

Mainstreet Waynesboro teamed with the State Historic Preservation Office to accomplish a long-time goal: Getting Waynesboro's downtown and surrounding area placed on the National Register of Historic Places. The district includes the core of downtown, from Franklin Street to Clayton Avenue, and Clayton Avenue between Main Street and 5th Street, including adjacent blocks and cross streets.

The designation is a source of pride for Waynesboro, which loves its history, and opens the door for grants and tax incentives for property owners.

LITTLE THINGS MEAN A LOT

Mainstreet Waynesboro was named a National Main Street America Affiliate Program for the sixth time in seven years and continues to be active on the regional and state levels.

Mainstreet staff and volunteers also played a lead role in keeping the Waynesboro Theatre alive after the company running it dissolved in July of 2020. The renovated downtown movie theater now features regular showings and is available for rentals and fundraisers to benefit the community.

Mainstreet also continued two of its most popular projects: the Downtown Window StoryWalk project remained a hit with families, and we installed our second downtown mural, a tall painted tribute to our first responders on the west wall of Christine's Café.

Mainstreet welcomed several new businesses to downtown Waynesboro this year, including Bathe, For the Love of Dogs and Graceful Beauty Boutique. We also saw our downtown storefront vacancy rate fall to less than 5 percent.
